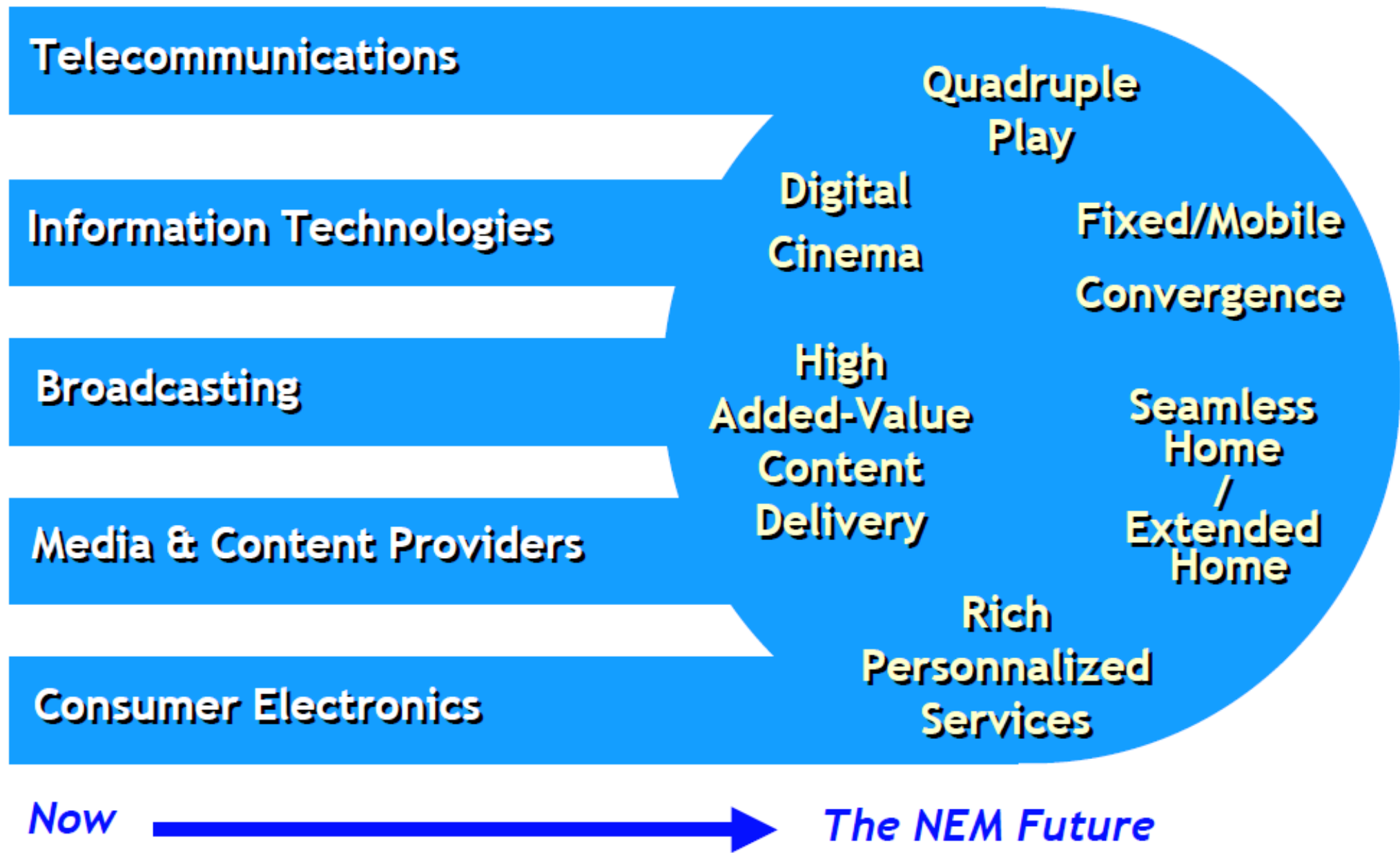

NEM points towards...

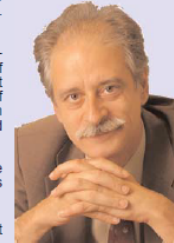
